- Computers *
 - CPUs
 - Ink Cartridges
 - Keyboards
 - Mouse
 - PDA's
 - Phones
 - TV sets (less than 36 in) **
 - Video Game Consoles
- * \$10 charge for comp monitors
** 15 charge for televisions
- BOTH CHARGES WILL BE ADDED TO YOUR NEXT UTILITY BILL.

Electronic Waste Recycling

- Unacceptable items
- Small Appliances (ex. Blenders, Vacuums)
 - Televisions over 36 inches



Metal & appliance recycling

- Acceptable items
- Basketball poles
 - Bicycles
 - Exercise equipment
 - Freezers
 - Metal Edging
 - Outdoor Grills
 - Refrigerators
 - Swing Set

Acceptable items

- Aerosol cans
- Antifreeze
- Batteries (household, cellphone, car, boat)
- CFL Bulbs
- Cooking Oil (used or dated)
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Gasoline
- Household cleaners
- Motor oil & filters

Location - 6616 Walnut St.
Entry to Center is off 2nd street on the Northeast side of Environmental Services

Hours of operation

Summer Hours of Operation (March - September)
Wednesdays 2-6 pm Saturdays 8 am - 1 pm

Winter Hours of Operation (October-February)
Wednesdays 2-5 pm Saturdays 8 am - 1 pm

Proof of Frisco residency

A valid Texas drivers' license and matching current Frisco Utility Bill is required for all disposal during HCD hours.

Transporting Household Chemicals

- Never mix chemicals.
- Don't eat, drink or smoke while handling household hazardous wastes.
- Do not transport in the same part of your vehicle as children or pets.
- Keep waste products in their original containers.
- Place items in a box to prevent spillage.
- Gasoline is highly flammable and should only be transported in purpose-designed cans or containers.
- Wash your hands after handling these materials.
- Place tape over TV or monitor screens to prevent breakage.

Restriction

Items containing Freon will be subject to a \$40 extraction fee which will be added to your next utility bill.



Household Chemical Disposal

Unacceptable items

- Ammunition
- Biological active materials
- Explosives
- Medical waste (syringes)
- Radioactive materials
- Old prescription pills
- Oxygen containers
- Tires

Restriction

Ten gallon limit per product, per visit.
Larger quantities are considered "business" or "commercial" waste and are not acceptable.
