SMARTER IRRIGATION THROUGH REUSE WATER

Pearson Farms also made the decision to participate in Frisco's reuse water, or purple pipe, program. This means that water from residential or commercial use is reclaimed, cleaned, and recycled for irrigation purposes.

To further ensure water consciousness, Pearson Farms has their landscape company on-call, 24 hours a day to respond quickly to any leaks or broken or misaligned sprinkler heads keeping water loss to a minimum.
